

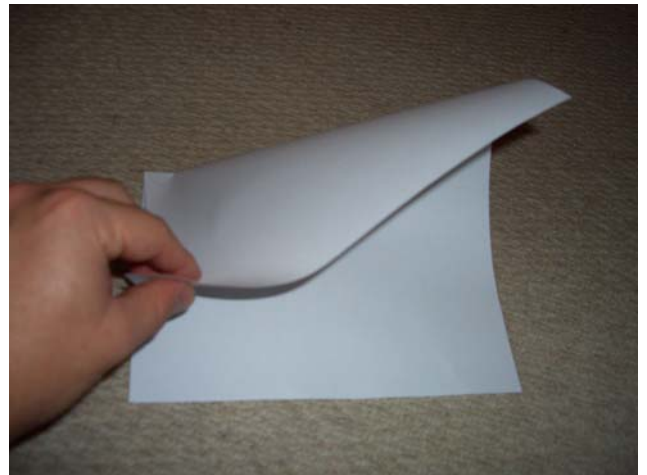
How to make a paper boat

You can make a boat that really floats out of an A4 piece of paper.
If you want it to last longer, use waxed paper!



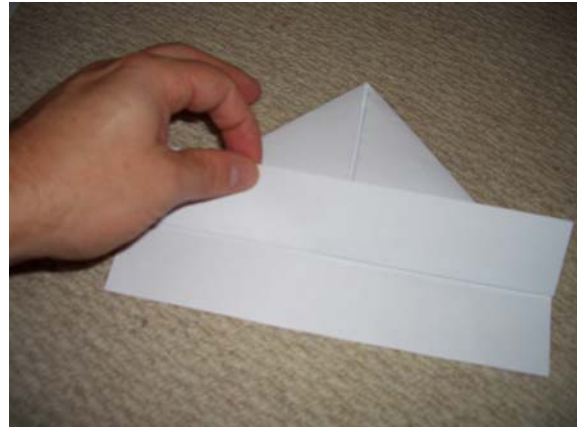
Start with an A4 piece of paper

Fold it in half, top to bottom



Fold the top two corners
(on the folded edge)
down into the middle
of the paper

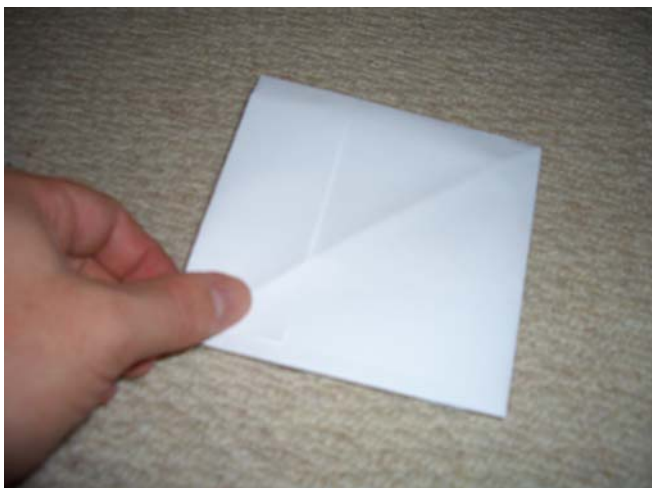
Fold the bottom of the paper up against both sides



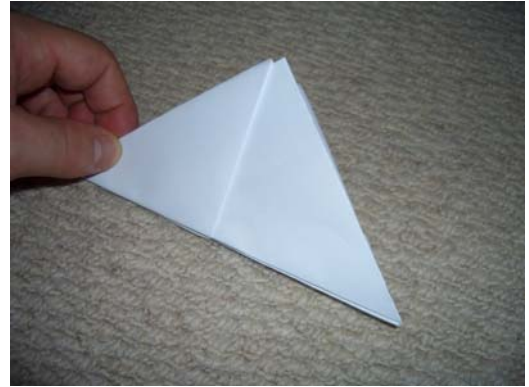
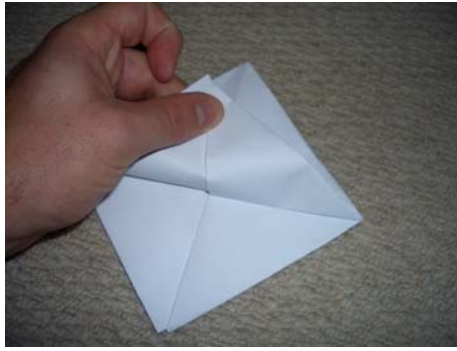
Fold the small triangular corners in, lapping them over each other so you are left with a large triangle



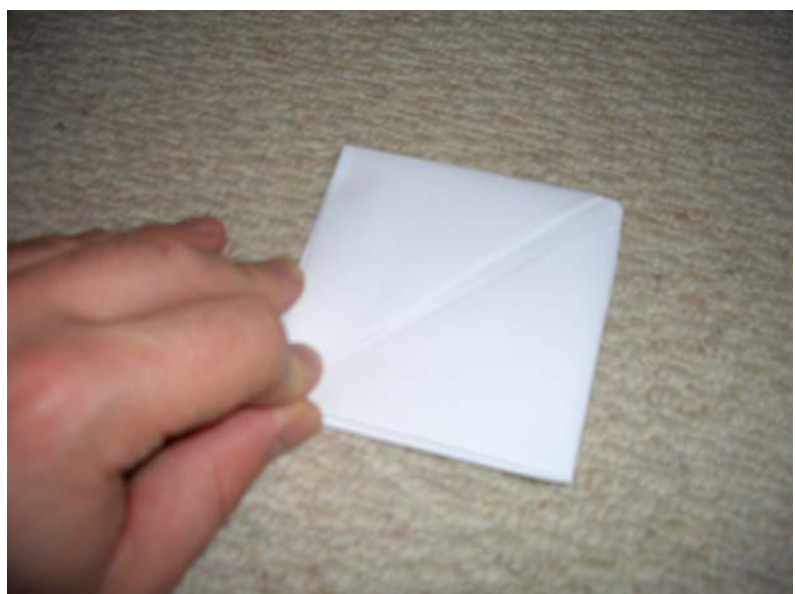
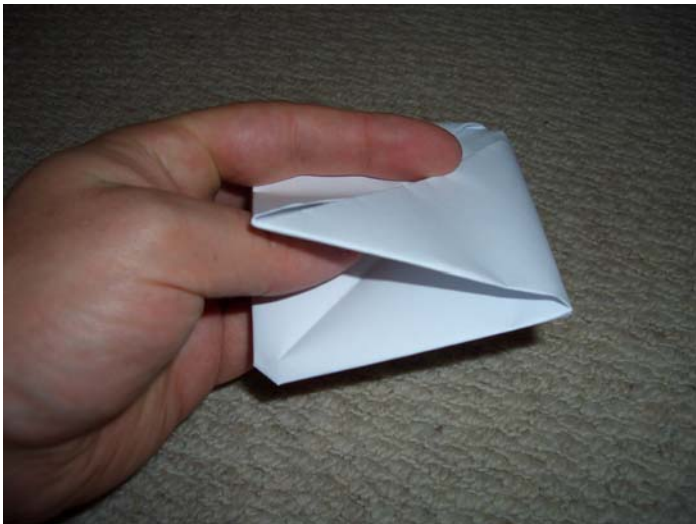
Hold the two bottom corners of the triangle and push them together so the sides push out and when you put the corners together, you form a square

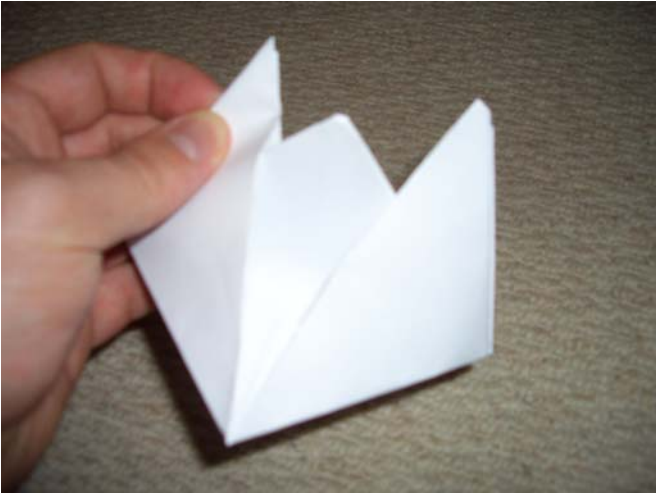


Hold it with the flaps down and fold the corners up to the top point on each side, making a smaller triangle



Again, push the bottom corners together, so that the middle folds out and when you put the corners together, you form a square





At the top there should be two triangles. Pull the top corners gently apart.

You should now have a paper boat that really floats!!
